Invitational Date/Place:	Friday, October 12, 2018 (Please do not arrive prior to 3:00pm) Oxford Hills Golf Club - 300 E. Drahner Rd., Oxford 48371
	3:00 p.m. – Course open for parking 4:15 p.m. – Boy's Junior Varsity Race 4:45 p.m. – Girls' Junior Varsity Race 5:15 p.m. – Varsity Boy's Race 5:45 p.m. – Varsity Girls' Race 6:15 p.m. – Open Race
Format:	Boy's race first in 2018, per MHSAA rules. Athletes will be called to the starting line 10 minutes before the race begins. Times are approximate.
Entries:	\$200 per school or \$100 per gender. Checks should be payable to <i>Oxford Community Schools</i> . Checks are due on or before race day. Entries must be made through www.athletic.net before Wednesday, October 10, 2018 by 6:00 PM
Team Scoring:	For the varsity races, you may start with ten (10) runners. The top five will score, (as usual) This should help you in determining who your top seven (7) runners for the MHSAA Regional. Runners 6-10 will count as "displacers" in scoring.
Location:	Oxford Hills Golf Club is located at 300 E. Drahner Rd., Oxford (48371) near the corner of M-24 and Drahner road, one mile south of the Village of Oxford. If you are traveling north on I-75/M-24 please add 15 to 30 minutes to your trip time depending on traffic, as construction has been heavy and plentiful on M-24 in 2018.
Runner Identification:	Greg Everal Racing will be handling the technical portion of the timing system
Starting:	Your team will receive a pre-assigned box on the starting line as drawn by the meet manager. Assignments will be part of each team's packet on race day available at the finish line.

Finish:	There will be a chute at the finish line. All runners must cross the finish line, stay on their feet and enter the chute in the order that they finish. There will be officials to make sure each runner complies. If a runner is sick or injured in the chute we will try to keep his/her position.
Awards:	The champion, runners-up and third place teams will receive trophies. The top 40 finishers will receive medals, at the finish chute. Please pick up trophies and medals at the finish line. No ceremony.
(JV)	There will be no team champion. The top 40 JV runners will receive a medal in each race. There will be no limit on the number of entries per school in this race. Coach assistance is required to help athletes get through the chute in the Junior Varsity Race. This is also the case for the Open Race, athletes will not be timed in the open.
Results:	Varsity results will be posted for download at www.athletic.net after the meet.
Special Note:	<i>We are fortunate to be able to use this facility to run this meet each year. We ask your cooperation in keeping the course free of litter and in better shape than when you came. Inform your runners to stay off greens and avoid golfers playing the front nine. The clubhouse is not open to runners. Portable restrooms are available near the bus parking area and at the start of the race. Failure to cooperate with these rules could mean school or team disqualification. Please, DO NOT BRING DOGS TO THE MEET! THANK YOU!</i>
Locker Rooms:	Dressing facilities are not provided. The clubhouse will <u>NOT</u> be available to student-athletes.
Golf Carts:	Golf carts are available to rent. All drivers, especially students, should drive with caution. Do NOT permit more than two people to ride in the cart and most importantly, return the cart to the storage area when the meet is finished.
Medical:	Members of the Oxford Fire Department Emergency Medical Team will be available if medical assistance is needed.
